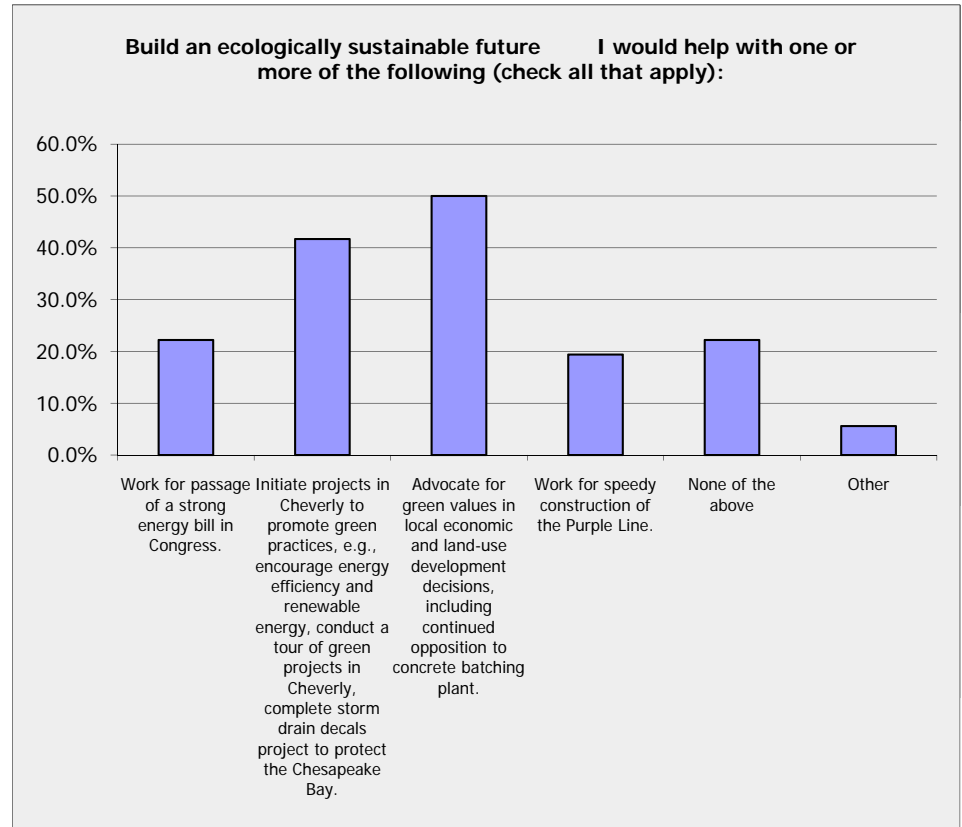

 I travel so much that I am unable to commit to any longer-term volunteering. However, I am willing, if able to do short-term projects.

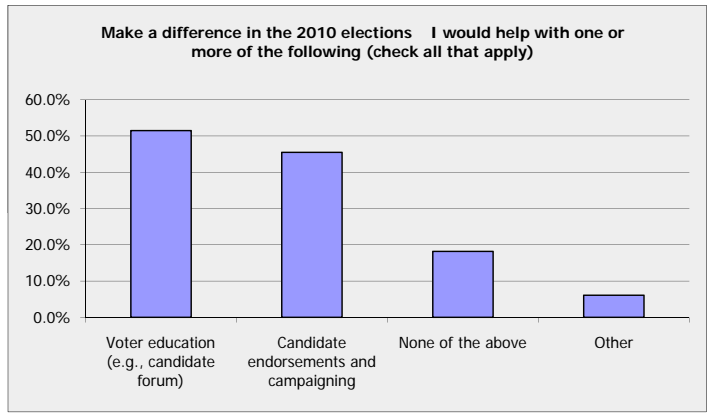

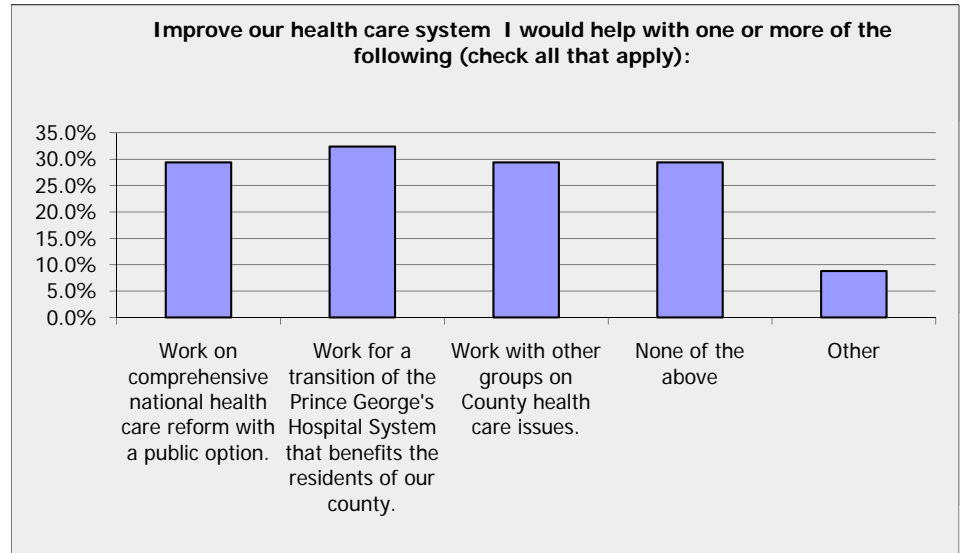

Not sure how citizens can help sale of Hospital. There has been so much secrecy.

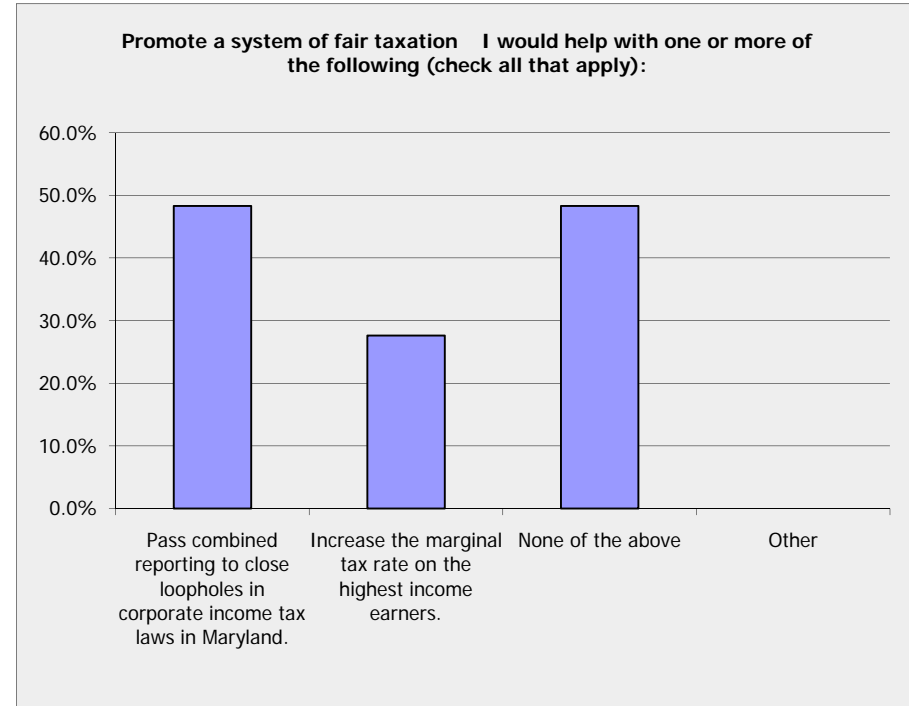

I'm hoping that when a national immigration is considered, we'd get involved.

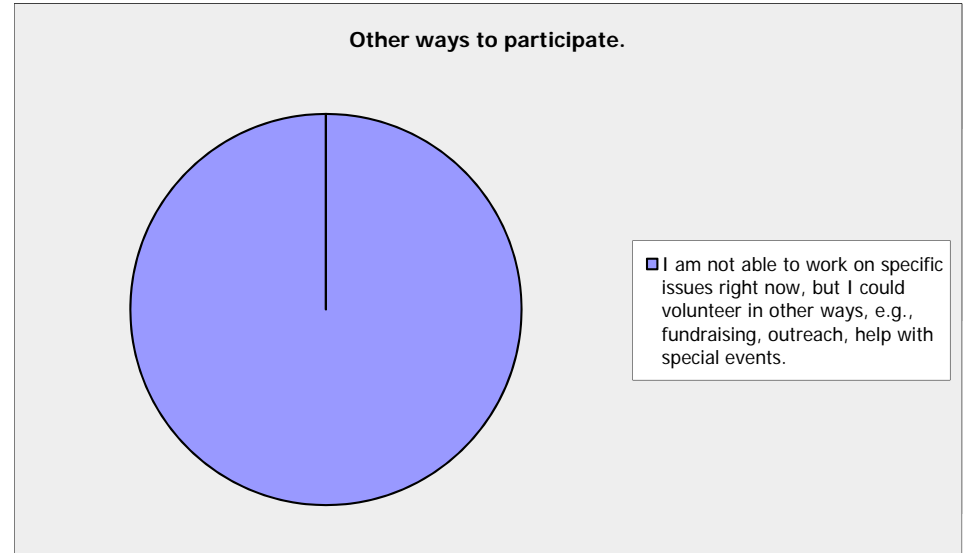

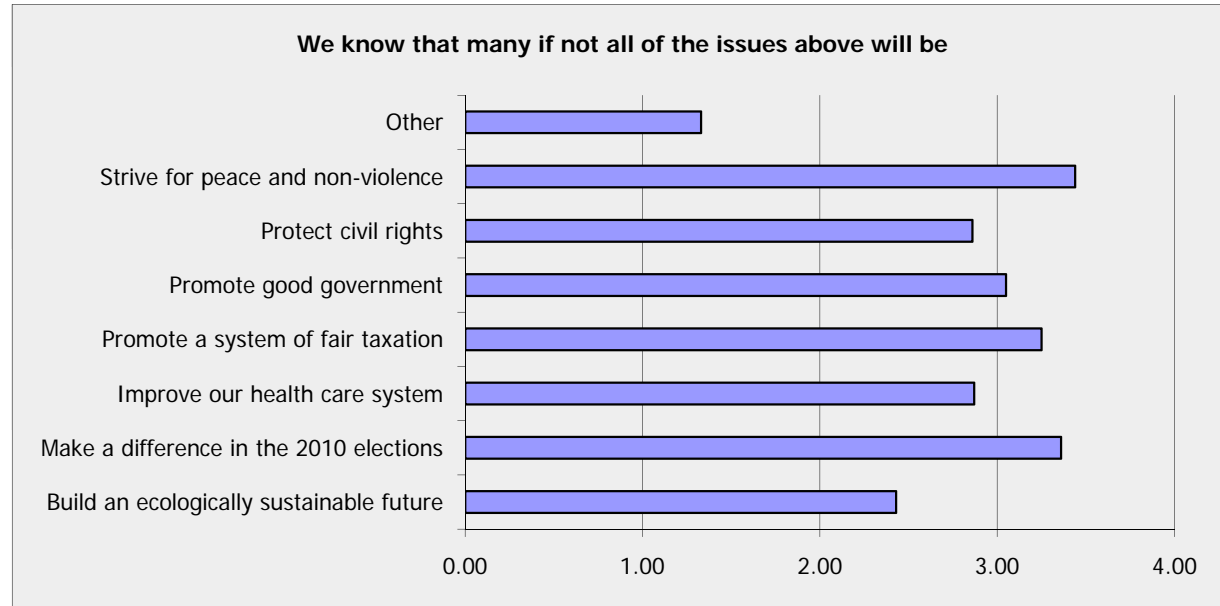

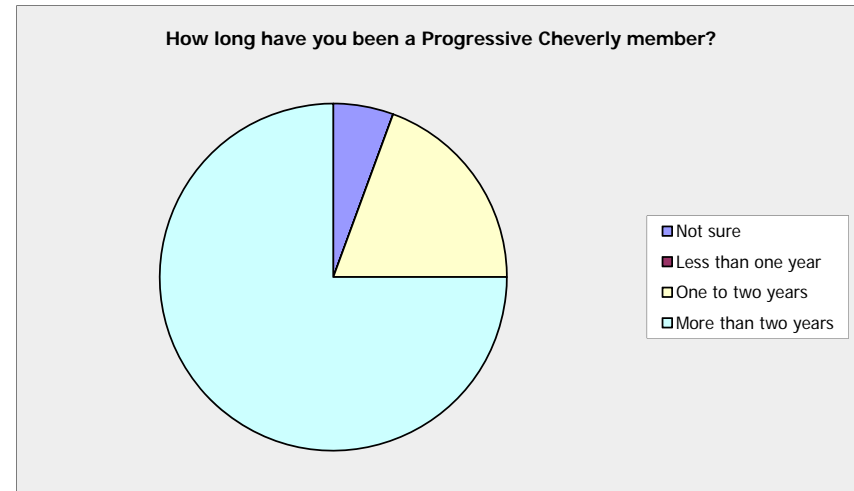

How long have you been a Progressive Cheverly member?

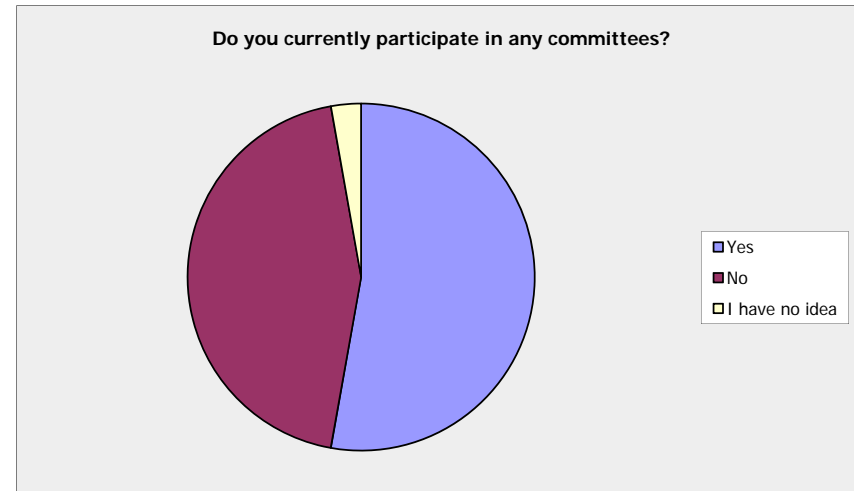

Do you currently participate in any committees?

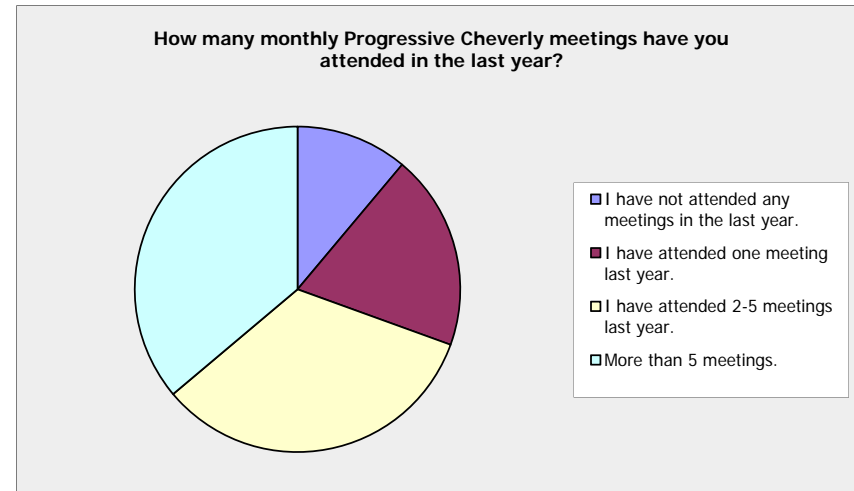

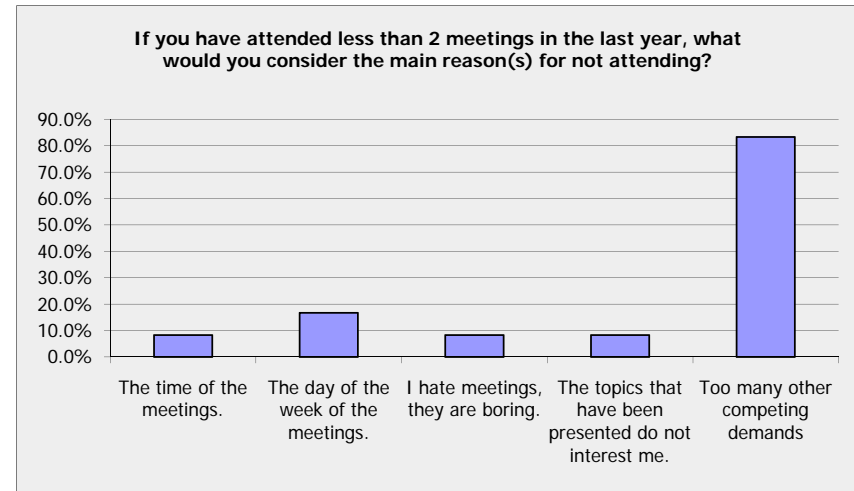

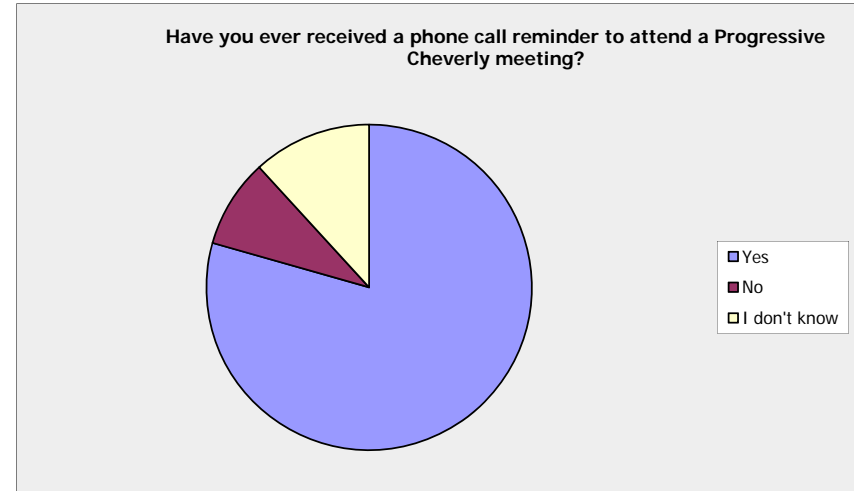

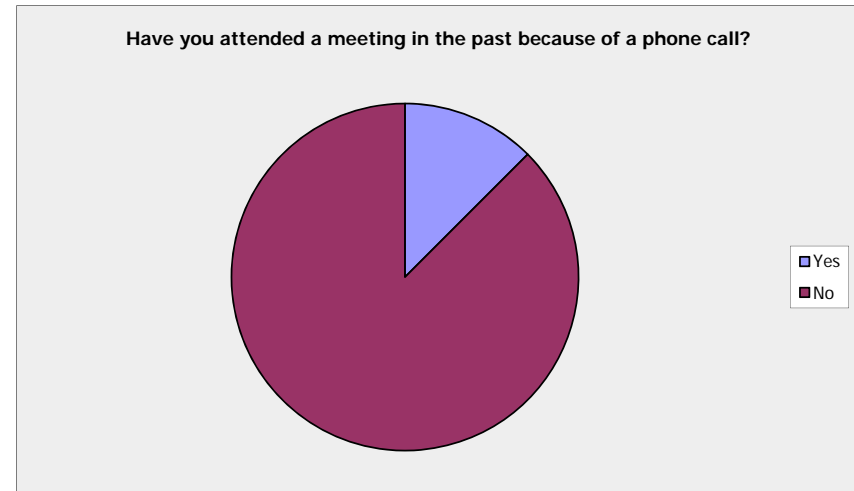

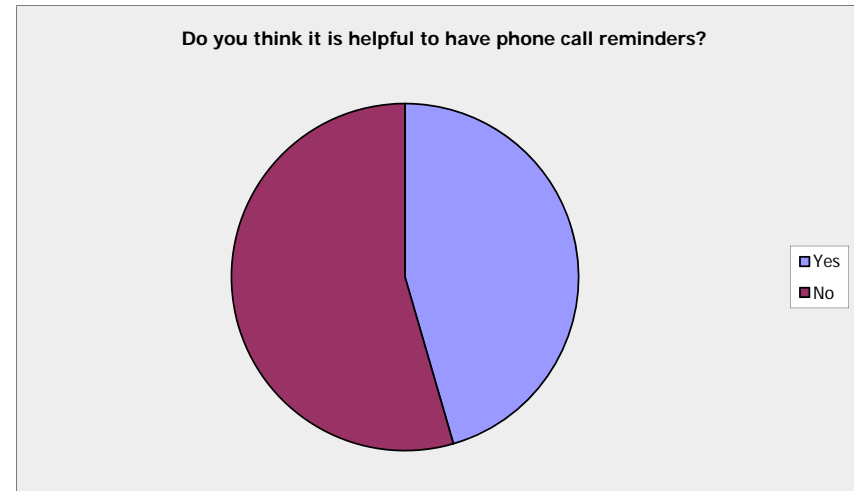
